

2022 Scholarship Application Instructions, Eligibility Criteria, and Deadlines

The Tri-City Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) is a 501(c)(4) nonprofit organization and one of 2,200 local units and state conferences. The longtime mission of the NAACP is to ensure the political, educational, social, and economic equality of rights of all persons and eliminate racial hatred and racial discrimination.

The Tri-City Branch will award Four (4) \$1,000.00 scholarships. The Application Period is April 14 thru May 31st, 2022.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicant must be a student of the graduating high school class of 2022 in the Tri-City areas of Fairfield, Suisun City, and Vacaville.
- Applicant must be a resident of Solano County.
- Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher based on a 4.0 scale.

PLEASE NOTE: All scholarship awards will be mailed to the Financial Aid Office of the student's college, university, or vocational school and are to be used for tuition, fees, books, and supplies. Funds will be released upon receipt of verification of enrollment in the 2022 Fall semester or quarter. **Funds will not be sent directly to students or to their families.**

The completed application, current official transcript, two letters of recommendation, and essay must be postmarked by May 31st, 2022. Applications that are incomplete or received after the deadline will not be accepted.

Please read the entire instructions and answer all questions. An incomplete or illegible application will result in disqualification. Please be sure to submit the following items:

- 1. A completed application typed or handwritten in black or blue ink, which must be legible.
- Two letters of recommendation: one academic (from a teacher or counselor) and one personal (from a minister, employer, community leader, or other individuals who are not related to the applicant)
- 3. A current official, sealed school transcript.
- 4. A small photo (headshot) will be used for publicity on the Tri-City Branch NAACP's website. Please be advised that the Photo will not be returned.
- 5. An essay, which must be 500 words (using the word count feature on Word), #12 font, and double spaced using the following Background Information and addressing one of the Essay Topics:
 - Background Information: On January 6, 2021, insurrectionists stormed the US
 Capitol in an attempt to prevent the certification of the 2020 presidential election
 results. While the insurrection was not successful, it represented a dangerous threat
 to US democracy. For the first time in American history, supporters of the losing
 presidential candidate forcibly disrupted the official counting of electoral votes.
 - **Essay Topic**: How was the Capital Insurrection on January 6th, 2021 historically significant & how can individuals and politicians assist with protecting our democratic institutions?

Essays will be evaluated based on 1) organization, 2) originality, content and focus, 3) grammar and spelling, and 4) word count and neatness.

Successful applicants will be notified of their interview date via email during the week of **June 13**, **2021**. Interviews will be required of all scholarship finalists. No makeup interviews will be scheduled.
